Champagne & Prosecco

Champagne Dericbourg Cuvée de Reserve, Champagne France, NV, ABV 12% | £48.00

Fabulously traditional style with gentle biscuit flavours complimented by deliciously refined grapey fruit flavours.

A fantastically quaffable Champagne that is magnificent on its own or with canapés at a drinks party.

Prosecco Vino Vispo, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy, NV, ABV 10.5% | £28.00

This wonderfully pretty Prosecco is so beautifully balanced and fresh, with ripe melon and pear flavour. Perfectly pair with antipasti, canapés and salads.

House White

Tarabilla Blanco, Galicia, Spain, 2015, ABV 11% | £20.00

A delicious blend that makes this very easy drinking and full of fresh green apple citrus and pear flavours, with attractive balance and a clean, crisp finish.

Rhanleigh Chardonnay, Robertson, South Africa, 2015/2016, ABV 14% | £23.00

Full of rich and ripe aromas of lemon, lime and a touch of vanilla - this is a crisp and elegant wine with a long finish and subtle hints of oak.


House Red

Tarabilla Tinto, Galicia, Spain 2014, ABV 12% | £20.00

Three way blend of peppery Garnacha, rich Tempranillo and a sizeable dollop of Cabernet Sauvignon. Warm and beautifully balanced, this is perfect on its own or with grilled meats and tapas.

Rhanleigh Cabernet Sauvignon, Robertson, South Africa, 2016, ABV 14% | £23.00

Aromas of blackberry and blackcurrant, medium bodied with a long finish.

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

Harrow & Hope Brut Reserve, Marlow, England, NV, ABV 12% | £45.00

From the rolling Chiltern Hills of the Thames Valley, this wine is produced in the same rigorous way as Champagne with the same grape varieties producing an elegant, moreish wine.

Laurent Perrier La Cuvée, Tours Sur Marne, France, NV, ABV 13% | £55.00

From the largest family owned Champagne house - this NV is well balanced, with a fresh and elegant creamy texture.

Laurent Perrier Rosé, Tours Sur Marne, France, NV, ABV 13% | £67.00

Pretty raspberry hints, this fresh, crisp Champagne shows flavours of strawberry, redcurrant, raspberry and fine black cherries.

Rosé Wine

Pinot Grigio Rosé Sentito, Veneto, Italy, 2013, ABV 12% | £24.00

Beautifully delicate, aromatic and pure on the nose, with flavours of strawberry and raspberry on the palate, this crisp, and flavoursome wine is ideal for a lazy summer's day.

Mas Fleurey Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France, 2015, ABV 13% | £28.00

Pale pink colour; fragrant strawberry and raspberry flavours. This wine is dry and crisp with a lovely delicate Provence style.

Dessert Wine

Orolyce Moscato d'Asti DOCG, Paolo Pizzorni, Piedmont, Italy, 2016, ABV 5.5% | £27.50

Delicately sparkling Italian wine, with elderflower, white peach and nectarine on the palate. Light in colour and on the palate, this wine is ideal to compliment dessert or as a light aperitif.

Château Simon, Sauternes, France (375 ml), 2010, ABV 13.50% | £30.00

The 2009 from Château Simon is an absolutely stellar effort. It is intensely sweet, showing great purity and texture, with classic barley sugar flavours and really good length.

Port

Smith Woodhouse Ruby Port, NV, ABV 19% | £35.00


Dark and lively Ruby colour. On the nose, intense red fruit aromas dominate, with some floral hints. On the palate, fresh and robust fruit flavours with an excellent long finish.

Corney & Barrow Tawny Port, 10 years old, ABV 19.5% | £37.50

A delicious end to a meal, resonating with nuts, dried fruits and hints of mocha.

Taylors LBV, 2011, ABV 20% | £40.00

Deep ruby red colour, black morello cherry on the nose, great vibrancy and wonderful freshness of fruit. On the palate, cassis, plums and blackberry combine harmoniously with the well-integrated and tightly knit tannins with a long elegant finish.



White Wine

La Source Réserve Blanc, Pays d'Oc, France, 2016, ABV 12.50% | £24.00

This delicious southern French blend shows lovely confit of lemon on the nose with hints of almond. On the palate, it has juicy citrus fruit with a touch of white pepper on the finish.

The War Horse Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2015, ABV 13.50% | £26.00

Sensational, explosively refreshing Chenin by tip-top producer simonising with sun kissed appley fruit flavours. It's perfect to quaff on its own and has the vibrancy and freshness to be enjoyed with fish dishes and salads.

Clef d'Argent Sauvignon Blanc, Pays d'Oc, France, 2015, ABV 12.50% | £26.50

This lovely Southern French Sauvignon is straw coloured with a gooseberry-green fruit nose and lemon zest - expansive, flamboyant, luscious and refreshing.

Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine Sur Lie 'Les Roches Gaudinieres', Domaine Derame, Loire Valley, France 2015, ABV 12% | £27.00

Light bodied with fresh green apple, citrus fruit flavours and crisp acidity. Time on lees adds a gentle roundness and extra dimension to the wine.

Marterey Chardonnay, Pays d'Oc IGP, France, 2015, ABV 13.50% | £28.00

Deliciously fruity with a touch of blossom and vanilla aromas, explosive flavours combine with richness and texture of the subtle oak.

Clarence River Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2016, ABV 12.50% | £29.50

This wine is true to its Marlborough origins, with a mix of ripe tropical and citrus fruits and cooler notes of fresh herbs.

Mâcon La Roche Vineuse, Château La Greffiere, France, 2015, ABV 13% | £32.00

This is classic Mâcon from one of the leading properties in the region. Golden straw yellow in colour, with aromas of ripe citrus fruits and complemented by delicious minerality and mouth-watering grapefruit flavour.

Lyme Bay Shoreline, Devon, England, 2015, ABV 11% | £34.00

It is a wine for seafood; well balanced and refreshing with complex layers. This beautiful wine has subtle notes of rose petal, pineapple and lime.

Bellvale Chardonnay 'Athena's Vineyard', Victoria, Australia, 2012, ABV 13% | £37.00

This 2012 Chardonnay from Bellvale combines ripe stone fruit character with a wonderful purity. It has a lovely lingering finish with subtle vanilla notes.

Pouilly-Fumé 'Les Duchesses', Domaine Laporte Loire Valley, France, 2015, ABV 13% | £38.00

On the nose, lime and flint stone notes with a hint of smokiness. Les Duchesses has elegant and well balanced flavours with kiwi fruit and gooseberries that leap into a fresh and clean tang with a delicious zesty citrus finish.

Evergreen Riesling Washington, USA, 2013, ABV 13% | £39.50

This Riesling is remarkably well balanced, opening up with white peach, honeysuckle and mineral notes. On the palate a hint of sweetness is balanced by fresh acidity, finishing with lovely flavours of Granny Smith apple, mandarin and orange.

Chablis 1er Cru, Romain Bouchard, Burgundy, France, 2013, ABV 13% | £43.50

From a warmer 1er Cru vineyard at one of the area's best producers, showing ripe citrus fruit alongside length and minerality at a young age.



Red Wine

La Source Réserve Rouge, Pays d'Oc, France, 2016, ABV 12.5% | £24.00

Seamlessly blends the soft ripe fruits from the Cabernet and Merlot, with the vibrant sweet spices of Syrah. As in Bordeaux, the Cabernet Franc gives the wine structure and a fabulous nose while the Petit Verdot gives the 2016 blend notes of chocolate and a rich creamy texture.

The War Horse Shiraz, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2015, ABV 13.5% | £26.00

Dark plum colour, vibrant aromas of raspberries, cherries, with a note of blackberries and gentle flavours of vanilla with elegant plum ending.

Valcheta Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2015, ABV 13% | £27.50

Winemaker Jon Usabiaga has made a textbook Malbec from Mendoza, with youthful, ripe blackcurrant aromas and slight hints of dark chocolate; it is a deliciously balanced wine with a pleasing spicy finish.

Lacrimus, Bodegas Sendero Royal, Rioja, Spain, 2015, ABV 13.50% | £28.00

The bright, fleshy and modern flavours of the young Tempranillo wine have harmonised beautifully with the older, softly oaked, barrel-aged Rioja to make this silky, modern, slightly fleshier, bright style of Rioja.

Côtes du Rhône, 'Esprit Barville', Rhône Valley, France, 2014, ABV 13% | £29.00

This is a red that is smooth, warming and elegant. Its aromas recall wild red fruits, liquorice and a hint of pepper and thyme.

Valpolicella Classico, Damoli Bruno, Veneto, Italy, 2015, ABV 12.50% | £32.00

This voluptuous Valpolicella has a vibrant ruby red colour with aromas of cherries, vanilla and spices. On the palate it is velvety and medium bodied with a soft, supple finish.

Polo Professional Reserve Malbec Mendoza, La Chamiza, Argentina, 2015, ABV 13.5 % | £35.00

Brilliant, intense red with aromas of plum and raspberry and vanilla notes from the oak. On the palate, it is well balanced with soft tannins and a velvety finish.

St John's Road 'Motley Bunch' GSM, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2013/2014, ABV 14.50% | £36.00

A mouth-watering blend of bright red fruits, dark plums and spice with a touch of chocolate and savoury tannins. This is a rich and flavoursome red that is subtle yet structured.

Esk Valley Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2015, ABV 13.5 % | £38.00

Lusciously smooth and beautifully elegant, this ravishing Pinot Noir has plummy, red cherry fruit and spicy complexity, finished off by mouth-watering acidity.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 'Le Calice de Saint Pierre, Domaine des Pères d'église, Rhône Valley, France, 2014, ABV 14.5% | £42.00

A clean, fresh and modern style blend with 95% Grenache, 2% Syrah and 3% Mourvèdre. This aromatic wine is full of spice, black pepper and sweet red fruits.

Navajas Gran Reserva, Rioja, Spain, 2005, ABV 14% | £42.50

Deep tawny and mahogany colour with smooth sweet vanilla, black cherries, earthy and truffle aromas. Following through to heavenly, velvet flavours of sweet fruit cake and a full, ripe finish.

Château d'Arcole, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France – Organic, 2014, ABV 13% | £45.00

Rich tawny and mahogany in colour with smooth sweet vanilla, black cherries and a mouth-watering fruit cake flavour.
